Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections 43 and 51, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1898, chapter 123, Article 4, of the Code of Local Laws, title 'Baltimore City,' sub-title 'Charter,' relating to the collection of taxes."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 326, of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to amend the charter of and grant additional powers to the Centenary Biblical Institute of the Methodist Episcopal Church of Baltimore city, a corporation incorporated under the General Laws of Maryland."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

BILLS—SECOND READING.

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 1 and 3 of chapter 540 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1894, being an Act to authorize the Great Falls Power Company to erect dams, hold real estate, and to erect and maintain lines for the transmission of electricity in Montgomery and Prince George counties, in the State of Maryland, and to add an additional section thereto, to be called section 3 A'; grant certain additional powers, rights and privileges unto the said Great Falls Power Company."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

By Committee on Corporations,

Amend section 1, by striking out all after the word "however" in line 23, and inserting the following:

"That the acceptance of this Act shall oblige and bind the Great Falls Power Company not to take, occupy, use, interfere with or damage, any property or right vested in the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, acquired as the successor of the Potomac Company or otherwise, and not to endanger any part of the canal or works of said canal company in any degree by liability to flood, except
