AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

By Committee on Revaluation and Assessment,

Strike out all after the word "a bill" and insert as follows:

Entitled "An Act to repeal section 688 A of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Licenses,' as said section was enacted by chapter 505 of the Acts of 1898."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 688 A of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Licenses,' be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect at the date of its passage.
