

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

By the Judiciary Committee,

In line 13, in section 67, after the word "dollars," add the words "and not more than twenty-five dollars."

In line 16 after the word "Act," add the words "provided that this Act shall not apply to Baltimore city."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Duncan, from Committee on Temperance, reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquor and lager beer within one mile of any public school in Election District No. 12, Precinct No. 1, in Frederick county, Maryland."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Mr. King, from Committee on Elections, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act providing for the selection of candidates for election by popular vote, and relating to elections."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Lehmayr, from Committee on Judiciary, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 702, of the Acts of 1892, sub-titled 'An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 217, of Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Religious Corporations,' and to add an additional section thereto, to be amended section 217 A.'"

Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Testamentary Law,' sub-title 'Wills,' to be known as 'Section 316 B.'"

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Collins, from the Committee on Claims, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to refund to Alexander Milner a sum of money paid by him to the Comptroller of the Treasury of the State, and covered into the Treas-
