Mr. Lehmayr, from the Judiciary Committee, reported unfavorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend chapter 149 of the Laws of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1896."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Mr. Roberts, from Committee on Chesapaake Bay and Tributaries, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 10 and 42, and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 15, 19, 22, 34, 36, 40, 45, 57, 58, 59, 60, 62, 63, 66 and 67, of Article 72, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Oysters,' and to add a new section thereto, to be known as '46 A,' and to follow section 46."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Lehmayr, from Judiciary Committee, reported unfavorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 7, of chapter 457, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1898, entitled an Act to repeal Article 45, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Husband and Wife,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."
