House bill, entitled "An Act to make valid powers of attorney made by married women."

House bill, entitled "An Act to amend sections 1 and 2, of chapter 344, of the Acts of 1896, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the Fraternal Trust and Banking Company,' so that the corporate title of the said corporation shall hereafter be the 'City Trust and Banking Company,' and further amend said Act so as to authorize the election of twenty-five directors or less."

After the word "banking," in line 3, section 1, add the word "company."
