Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably, with request that same be sent to Committee on Roads and Highways,

House bill entitled "An Act to permit all turnpike companies incorporated under the General Laws of the State or by the Act of Assembly, to charge tolls upon all vehicles or conveyances propelled by other than horse power."

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Roads and Highways.

Also, favorably, with request that same be sent to Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Its Tributaries.

House bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Chesapeake and Patuxent Oyster Company."

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Its Tributaries.

Mr. Norris, from Committee on Hygiene, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add two new sections to be designated '149 A, 149 B,' to Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' under the sub-title 'Health,' to be preceded by the word 'Calves.'"

Which was read a first time.

Also unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub title 'Health,' by adding thereto three additional sections, to follow section 147 C, to be numbered Sections 147 D, 147 E and 147 F, respectively, and to be preceded by the heading 'Second-Hand Bottles or Jars.'"

Which unfavorable report was adopted.
