Mr. Close, from Select Committee, reported favorably, Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Frederick county to issue bonds bearing interest at a rate not to exceed three and one half per centum per annum, to obtain money to redeem the sixty-five thousand dollars of bonds, bearing interest at four per centum per annum, issued by said county commissioners under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of 1884, chapter 494, and also to redeem the one hundred and twenty-three thousand and seven hundred dollars of bonds, bearing interest at four per centum per annum, issued by said county commissioners under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of 1886, chapter 259, both of which issues of bonds are now redeem. able and may be paid by said county commissioners and to authorize and empower the said county commissioners to levy and collect the necessary taxes for the payment of the bonds authorized to be issued and the interest thereon."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Feldmeyer, from Select Committee, reported unfavorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 218, 219, 220 and 221 of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'Stock and Swine,' and to re-enact same with amendments."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Mr. Contee, from Select Committee, reported favorably,
