Strike out all after "a bill" and insert in lieu thereof, the following:

"Entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 75 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Pleadings, Practice and Process at Law,' sub-title 'Ejectment,' to come in after section 69, and to be known as 'Section 69 A.' "

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be added to the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Pleadings, Practice and Process at Law,' sub-title 'Ejectments' to come in after section 69, and to be known as 'Section 69 A,' and to read as follows:

69 A. That an outstanding mortgage shall not prevent the real owner or mortgagor of said property from maintaining an action of ejectment against any person or persons other than the mortgagee or his, her or their assignees.

Sec. 2. Be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
