"Entitled an Act to repeal section 38 of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Public Education,' and sub-title 'Schools,' and re-enact the same with amendments, and to add a new section to said Article, to follow after section 38, and to be designated as 'Section 38 A.'"

"Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 38, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Public Education,' sub-title 'Schools,' be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, and a new section added thereto, to follow after section 38, and to be designated as 'Section 38 A.'"
