Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for an election to be held in Election District No. 5, or Queenstown District of Queen Anne's county to regulate the liquor traffic therein, and repealing section 193 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Queen Anne's County,' sub-title 'Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks,' as amended by the Act of 1896, chapter 348, and re-enacting the same with the addition of certain new sections to be designated as 'Sections 193 A, 193 B, 193 C, 193 D, 193 E and 193 F,' so as to read as hereinafter provided."

Endorsed "Read the third time and passed by year and nays."
