Mr. Norris, from Committee on Hygiene, reported unfavorably,

Mr. Deets, from Committee on Inspection, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the United Milk Producers Association of Baltimore city, by granting certain additional powers and privileges to the United Milk Producers Association."

Which was read a second time.

Mr. Roberts, from Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries, reported favorably, with proposed amendments,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 1 of Article 92 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Terrapin, Diamond Back' and re-enact the same with amendments."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED

By Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Its Tributaries:

Strike out all after "A Bill," and substitute as follows:

"Entitled an Act to repeal sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, of Article 92, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Terrapin, Diamond Back,' and re-enact the same with amendments.

"Section 1. Be it enacted, That sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, of Article 92, of the Code of Public General Laws, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
