House bill entitled "An Act to add three new sections to Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Harford County,' under the new sub-title 'Auctioneers,' to follow section 20, and to be known as 'Sections 20 A, 20 B and 20 C.'"

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Feldmeyer, from Select Committee, reported unfavorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment of a Board of Visitors for the Anne Arundel county jail, and defining the powers and duties of said board."

Mr. Wolfe moved to substitute the bill for the unfavorable report,

Which motion as rejected.

The unfavorable report was then adopted.

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message:

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for the issue of five hundred thousand dollars Maryland State bonds, for the purpose of erecting a new State Building in the city of Annapolis, and for the improvement of other State institutions, said bonds to be issued at a rate not higher than three and one-half per centum interest per annum, and to provide a sinking fund for the payment of said bonds."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Also delivered,

Senate bili entitled "An Act to add certain additional sections to Article 77, of the Code of the Public General Laws, to come in after section 17, to be known as 'Section 17 A, 17 B and 17 C,' and to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 71, of said Article,"

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Education.
