745, and to be designated as Sections 745 A, 745 B, 745 C, 745 D, 745 E and 745 F.

Which was read a second time.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to provide for a general index of Executors and administrators and guardians accounts, inventories and sales in the office of the Register of Wills of Montgomery county."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Montgomery county delegation.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 79, as re-enacted by chapter 281, of the Acts of 1890, and repealed and re-enacted by chapter 103 of the Acts of 1894, 80, 81 and 82, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'Birds, Game and Foxes,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 103, of the Acts of 1894, so far as said section relates to Anne Arundel county, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Game and Fish.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 75, of the Code of Public General Laws, to be known as 'Section 15 A,' of said Article."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
