

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, chapter 278, of the Acts of 1896, entitled an Act to confirm and amend the charter of the Cherry Hill, Elkton and Chesapeake City Electric Railway Company of Cecil county."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also returned,

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, from spending or appropriating any greater sum of money than they shall have levied upon the taxable basis of said county for the amount of expenses of said county for the ensuing year for which said levy is made."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county from issuing license to any person or company of circus riders, equestrian performers or to any person or company to exhibit for reward any animal or animals or natural or artificial curiosities (except models for useful inventions) during the months of August, September and October, (except to fair associations or persons authorized by them) and providing penalties for such unlicensed exhibitions."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act supplementary to an Act, entitled 'An Act to change the name and amend the charter of the Visitors of the Asylum and Training School for the Feeble-Minded of the State of Maryland, incorporated by the General Assembly of Maryland at its session of 1888, chapter 183, passed at the session of 1894, chapter 562,'"

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."
