The motion was adopted, and

The bill was read for a first time.

Also favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend the charter and extend the power of the Maryland Casualty Company."

Which was read a second time.

Also favorably, with proposed amendment,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to permit the United Railways and Electric Company of Baltimore to increase its Board of Directors from the present number, to-wit: nine (9) unto eleven (11), and to provide that of such number, two may be citizens and residents of States other than the State of Maryland."
