

number of his license, and shall affix the same securely to the mainsail, but on the opposite side thereof from that required by the State law, and shall keep the said number in proper position and plainly visible at all times while at work or going to or from work during the dredging season, and the provisions of this section shall not apply to Pocomoke Sound, wherein it shall be unlawful at all times to take oysters with scoop, scrape, drag or dredge, and said license shall not be transferable; and any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this section, or found guilty of dunnaging his or their boats to escape a just and proper measurement of the same by said custom house officials, shall be found guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, upon conviction before any justice of the peace or the Circuit Court for Somerset county, be fined in a sum of not less than one hundred dollars or more than three hundred dollars for each offence, or sentenced to the House of Correction for one year, or both in the discretion of the court or justice of the peace trying the same.

"Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage."
