

3. In line 3, section 2, strike out the words "as directed," and insert as follows: "In their discretion."

4. In line 1, section 3, after the word "bond," insert as follows: "If it shall be decided to issue the same."

5. In line 1, section 4, after the word "county," insert as follows: "In case of the issue of said bonds as provided in section 3."

6. In line 4 of section 7, after the word "Commissioners," insert the following: "And said County Commissioners."

7. In line 7, section 7, after the word "shall," insert the word "have."
