Senate bill No. 275, entitled "An Act to authorize the Governor of Maryland to appoint L. Allison Wilmer, late Adjutant-General of Maryland, or some other person, to be selected by the Governor, the agent of the State of Maryland, to collect and recover, in the name of the Governor of Maryland, the balance due, or so much thereof as is collectable, of the claim of the State against the United States Government growing out of the furnishing and equipping of Maryland troops for the Volunteer Army of the United States in the late Spanish-American War, and providing compensation therefor."
