

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

By Mr. Putzel.

Amend by adding at the end of section 5 the following: "Provided, however, that said corporation shall be subject in all respects to the provisions of chapter 123 of the Acts of 1898, and to the ordinances of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, in so far as its operations may be carried on in the city of Baltimore, as a condition precedent thereto, and that nothing herein contained shall be construed to the contrary."
