House bill entitled "An Act to grant and declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland, to a sale and conveyance by J. Henry Judik and Lillie A. Judik, his wife, and Robert M. Jones and Mary A. Jones, his wife, their heirs or assigns, to the Keen Memorial Methodist Protestant Church of Baltimore city, of a certain lot of ground in Baltimore city, and to the holding of said lot by the said Keen Memorial Methodist Protestant Church of Baltimore city in fee simple with full power to dispose of the same."

House bill entitled "An Act to refund to George J. D. Disney, of the city of Baltimore, the amount erroneously paid by him into the Treasury of the State of Maryland for oyster measurer's license for the season of 1895 and 1896."
