Leave was granted to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter two hundred and forty-eight (248), of the Acts of 1894, of the Public General Laws, entitled "An Act to create a Fire Marshal for the State of Maryland."

Referred to the Judiciary Committee to be hereafter appointed.

Leave was granted to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 740 and 741, of Article 4, Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Police Commissioners," as amended and re-enacted by chapter 123, of the Acts of 1898, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
