

Loans to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, the second sub-section of section 122, of Article 23, of the Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Corporations,' sub-title 'Insurance Department.'"

On motion of Mr. Robinson,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add two additional sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Crimes and Punishments,' to provide when wages are to be paid, and to be arranged under the new sub-title 'Payment of Wages,' and to come in after section 149 in said Article, and to be known as 'Sections 149 A and 149 B.'"

On motion of Mr. Sanford,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, bequests and devises contained in the last will and testament of certain persons, late of the State of Maryland, deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons in the State of Maryland to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious incorporations, denominations or sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereafter named."

Leave was granted to the Committee on Hygiene, to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Article 27, sections 88, 89, 90 and 91, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub-title 'Fraud.'"

Leave was granted to the Committee on Elections, to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add additional sections to Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Elections,' to be designated as 'Sections 115, 116 and 116 A.'"
