Leave was granted to the Committee on Hygiene to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 88, 89, 90 and 91, of Article 27, Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub-title 'Fraud, Butter, Oleomargarine,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 46, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'County Treasurer.'

On motion of Mr. Mann,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 137 to 142, both inclusive, of Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' and to re-enact said sections with amendments, and to add new sections to said Article, to be designated as 'Sections 142 A, 142 B, 142 C and 142 D,' and to repeal chapter 597 of the Acts of 1890, entitled 'An Act to confer additional jurisdiction upon justices of the peace of Baltimore county,' and to repeal chapter 496 of the Acts of 1892, entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 3, of chapter 597, passed at January session, 1899, entitled an Act to confer additional jurisdiction upon justices of the peace of Baltimore county."
