Which was read a first time.

Mr. Lehmayr, from Judiciary Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendments.

House bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 21, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Conveyancing,' by adding a new sub-title to be designated 'Conveyances,' of five new sections to be designated 'Sections 88 B, section 88 C, section 88 D, section 88 E, section 88 F,' to come in after section 88 A, of said Article."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Staley, from the Committee on Education, reported with the recommendation that it be referred to the Washington county delegation,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 21, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Public Education,' sub-title 'School Commissioners,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."
