

## BILLS—SECOND READING.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Comptroller of the State Treasury and the Comptroller of Baltimore city respectively, to refund to Philip Lobe and Henry Rosenheim and Sons, moneys erroneously paid into the Treasury, respectively, of said State and municipality for licenses."

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' by adding a new section thereto, to be known as 'Section 75 A.'"

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 488, of the Acts of 1898, entitled 'An Act to amend Articles 4, 10 and 21, of the Code of Public Local Laws, titles, respectively, 'Caroline County, Dorchester County and Talbot County,' sub-title 'Fish,' by adding three new sections thereto, to be designated as "Section 146 A, of Article 6, section 182 A, of Article 10, and section 116 A, of Article 21."
