

of any other money appropriated by any Act of Assembly for the printing of the session of 1900; and the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to pay said sum or sums of money out of the money appropriated in the manner above mentioned, to the said William J. C. Dulany Company, or an order, or orders issued by the Chairman of the Committee on Printing of the House of Delegates, January session, 1900, and the said order shall be issued by the said Chairman of the Printing Committee aforesaid, on the presentation by the said Wm. J. Dulany Company to him of a certificate from the State Librarian that the said copies of the Manual so ordered have been delivered to the State Library.

The said State Librarian shall receive said fifteen hundred copies in each and every year, and shall, on each delivery in each year, issue to the said Wm. J. C. Dulany Company, the certificate of the delivery of the same, and the said State Librarian shall thereupon distribute the Manual according to the terms of this order.
