On motion of Mr. Linthicum,

Leave was granted to the Dorchester county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 29, of the Code of Public General Luws, title 'County Commissioners,' sub-title 'Damaging Lands,' to follow after section 49, and to be numbered '49 A."

On motion of Mr. Wilson,

Leave was granted to the Garrett county delegation and Mr. Hanson, to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to provide for the floating debt of Oakland, Md."

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message:

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 2, of chapter 36, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1898, relating to the creation of a new election district in Garrett county.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Garrett county delegation and Mr. Deets.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel county, sub-title 'Annapolis City," to be numbered 'Section 86,' relating to the encouragement of manufactures in said city."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Anne Arundel county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to alter and amend the charter, change the name of, and grant other and additional power to the stockholders of the Anne Arundel County Academy; a corporation incorporated by the General Assembly of Maryland, by Act of 1856, chapter 238."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 184 J, of Article 2, of the Code of
