Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 6, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Public Education,' sub-title 'Formation of Boards."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Education.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 614, passed at January Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1894."

Which was read a first time and referred to Anne Arundel county delegation.

House bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the George W.
