House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 222, Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'Sheriff,' as amended by the General Assembly of 1884, chapter 500."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the clerk of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county, to have prepared new Equity indexes of the Equity Dockets in his office."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, to change the grade of a public road in the thirteenth district of said county, commonly known as the 'Washington Turnpike Road,' at and near the place where the same crosses the Baltimore and Potomac Railroad at grade for the purpose of doing away with such grade crossing, and to provide for the construction of the bridge or bridges that may be made necessary thereby."
