Which was read a first time.

Also unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for a lien for threshing grain and shelling corn, and for its enforcement in Kent county."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Also favorably, with proposed amendment,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 45, of Article 63, of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled 'Mechanic's Lien.'"

Which was read a second time.

REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Collins, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 1, of Article 17, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Clerks of Courts,' and to re-enact the same with amendments, so far as the same applies to Talbot county."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Walsh, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal the 154th section of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland relating to the town of Taneytown, in Carroll county, as amended by section 154, chapter 584, of the Acts of 1894, and to re-enact the same in an amended form."

Which was read a first time.
