Leave was granted to the Washington county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, to borrow the sum of five thousand dollars for drainage purposes."

On motion of Mr. Sandman,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to license traders in Baltimore county."

By Mr. Walsh,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Westminister Water Company, of Westminister, Maryland, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Laws of this State."

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES.

Mr. Lehmayr, from the Committee on Judiciary reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 3, of Article 5, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Appeals and Errors,' sub-title 'Appeals from Courts of Law,' and to add a new section to said Article to take its proper place therein, and to be numbered 'Section 3 A.'"

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Also favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the grant of a parcel of land, described in a deed from Sarah J. Norris to the trustees of Mt. Zion Methodist Episcopal Church, of Harford county, dated the 3d day of January, 1900, and recorded among the Land Records of Harford county in Liber W. S. F. No. 98, folio 378."
