House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 7, of Article 45, of the Maryland Code of Public General Laws, title 'Husband and Wife,' as repealed and re-enacted by the Act of 1898, chapter 457, and re-enact the same with amendments."

House bill entitled "An Act to provide for transcribing and making a general index of marriage records in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 1, of Article 17, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Clerks of Courts," and to re-enact the same with amendments, so far as the same applies to Talbot county."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 73, of Article 23, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Wicomico County,' sub-title 'Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks,' as enacted by chapter 136, of the Acts of Assembly of 1896, and to re-enact the same with amendments."
