Amendment proposed by Judiciary Committee.

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

After word "Act" in line 37, insert the words "provided, nevertheless, that nothing in this act shall operate to divest any lien or claims upon property passing under such trustee's deed which may now exist, or which may hereafter arise for the benefit and protection of any *cestui que trust* where the purchase money may not have been properly applied."

Which was adopted.
