Leave was granted to the Committee on Elections, to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add 5 new sections to Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws, of Maryland, entitled 'Elections,' as re-enacted by chapter 202 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1896, to be numbered '63 A, 63 B, 63 C, 63 D and 63 E,' and to follow section 63."

On motion of Mr. Cover,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 32, of Article 9, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Attachment,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

On motion of Mr. Martenet,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to protect the citizens of this State from the impositions of fake corporations."
