No. 1, folio 130, etc., one of the incorporation records of Baltimore county, and also an amended incorporation under the general provision of the 26th Article of the Code by said Court, by which amendment said corporate name was changed to Mt. St. Joseph's College, of Baltimore county, and which is also on record in the clerk's office of said Court, of date June 9, 1881, and recorded in Liber J. B., No. 1, folio 297, etc., one of the incorporation records of Baltimore county."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
