Mr. Long, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Buckey, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Governor of Maryland to appoint a Notary Public for the town of Myersville, in Frederick county, Maryland."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Duncan, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendment,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city, to increase the pension of Charles A. Selvage, a retired policemen of the police force of Baltimore city."

Also unfavorably,
