BILLS—SECOND READING.

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 5, of Article 66, of the Code of Public Laws of Maryland, title 'Mortgages,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester county to borrow money upon the credit of the county for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the northwest fork of the Nanticoke river, in said county, at a point called 'Harrison's Ferry,' and placing a draw therein, to give their bonds or bills obligatory for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county, to redeem said bonds or bills obligatory and to pay the interest thereon."
