Leave was granted to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 295, of the Acts of Assembly of 1896, and chapter 282, of the Acts of 1898, of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, under the title of "Immigration." establishing a Bureau of Immigration in and for the State of Maryland.

Referred to the Judiciary Committee, hereafter to be appointed.

Leave was granted to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 19, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Public Education."

Referred to the Committee on Education, hereafter to be appointed.
