AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out after the word "capacity" in line 11, all of lines "12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and line 17," to the word "the," and insert in lieu thereof the following: "For the counties of Baltimore, Carroll, Frederick and Washington, the Governor shall appoint two members of the school board from the Republican party, two members from the Democratic party and two members from the Prohibition party; and in all other counties the Governor shall appoint one member of the school board from the Republican party, one member from the Democratic party, and one member from the Prohibition party."
