Mr. Buckley, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 91, of the Acts of 1894, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the town of Mount Airy, in Carroll and Frederick counties and the several Acts and parts of Acts amendatory thereof, and to re-enact the said Acts of 1894, with amendments."

Which was read a first time.
