On motion of Mr. Scrimger,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Agriculture to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add three additional sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Fraud,' sub-title 'Fruit and Vegetables.'"

On motion of Mr. Scrimger,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Comptroller of Baltimore city and the Comptroller of the State, respectively, to refund to August C. Schmidt, money erroneously paid into the Treasuries, respectively, of said State of Maryland and municipality for license."

On motion of Mr. Frenzel,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Game and Fish to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22, of Article 1, of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'Birds and Game.'"

On motion of Mr. Brown, of Baltimore city,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section four of the Code of Public Local Laws."
