Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 225, of Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Chancery,' sub-title 'Witnesses,' as the same was repealed and re-enacted with amendments by the Act of the General Assembly passed January session 1890, chapter 86, and as the same was repealed and re-enacted with amendments by the Act of the General Assembly, passed January session 1896, chapter 35."

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to give and grant the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to sundry gifts, leases, grants, devises and bequests of various persons in the State, to or for the use of sundry religious sects, orders, etc."
