floating indebtedness of the city of Annapolis, and to provide a fund for the permanent improvement of said city."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate bill No. 64, entitled "An Act to repeal section 92, of Article 5, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Appeals and Errors,' sub-title 'Appeals from Justices of the Peace,' so far as the same is applicable to Allegany county."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Allegany county delegation.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 25, of Article 20, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Constables,' sub-title 'Police, Duties of Constables,' in so far as the same relates to Frederick county."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Frederick county delegation.

Senate bill No. 42, entitled "An Act to provide for a State subscription to Perkins' Annotated Maryland Reports, and for an appropriation therefor."

Senate bill No. 106, entitled "An Act making an appropriation for the purpose of paying the expenses of the dedication of the Maryland Soldiers' Monument on the battlefield of Antietam.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the appointment of a Justice of the Peace, who shall have jurisdiction in and for the town of Takoma Park."
