House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower Junius M. Baker to construct in front of his property in the town of Cambridge, Dorchester county, a wharf or shell walk extending out into the Great Choptank river."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 488, of the Acts of 1898, entitled 'An Act to amend Articles 6, 10 and 21: of the Code of Public Local Laws, title respectively 'Caroline County,' 'Dorchester County,' and 'Talbot County,' sub-title 'Fish,' by adding three new sections thereto to be designated as 'Section 146 A, of Article 6, section 182 A, of Article 10, and section 116 A, of Article 21.'"

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 8, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, so far as the same relates to Harford county."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 615, of the Acts of 1890, entitled 'An Act to amend Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Harford County,' by adding additional sections thereto.'"

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Board of County Commissioners of Carroll county to erect and maintain boards, so painted and marked with letters and figures as to indicate the direction of and distance to the nearest town, city, village, postoffice, turnpike, or main road at the intersection of all county roads in said county."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 423 of Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick county, sub-title 'Roads.'"
