Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to change the grade of the public road in the Thirteenth District of said county, commonly known as the 'Washington Turnpike Road,' at and near the place where the same crosses the Baltimore and Potomac Railroad at grade, for the purpose of doing away with such grade crossing, and to provide for the construction of the bridge or bridges that may be made necessary thereby."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to extend the privileges, enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the George W. Albaugh Real Estate and Brokerage Company, of Carroll county, Maryland, so as to enable it to loan money on or purchase promissory notes, bills obligatory, or other evidences of debt."

Endorsed; "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 387 of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Miscellaneous Local Laws.'"

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.
