House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 126, of Article 27, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Talbot County,' sub-title 'Liquors and Intoxicating Drinks,' as amended by chapter 580, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session 1898, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Mr. Keys, from Select Committee, reported favorably, Senate bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Ceerl County,' sub-title 'Circuit Court,' relating to original writs."
