BILLS—SECOND READING.

House bill entitled "An Act authorizing the Antietam Battlefield Commission of Maryland to transfer to the perpetual care of the Government of the United States, the property acquired by them on the battlefield of Antietam, Maryland."

PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

In line 2, after the word "and," insert the word "it."

Which was adopted.

In line 6, after the figures "294," insert the words "of the Acts of."

Which was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was read a second time.

House bill entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to meet the deficiencies in the appropriations of certain contingent funds for the fiscal year 1900."

Which was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

House bill entitled "An Act to empower the Mayor and Common Council of Westminster, in Carroll county, to call in the bonds of the city of Westminster, issued by authority of sections 248, 249, 250 and 251, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, and to raise money therefor by issuing other bonds of said city."

Which was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

House bill entitled "An Act to take away the remedy of distress for ground rents in Baltimore city in certain cases."

In the bill, after the word "city," insert "and Baltimore county."
