Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to incorporate an association of citizens at Church Hill, Queen Anne's county, State of Maryland, under the name, style and title of Washington Camp, No. 13, Patriotic Order Sons of America, of the State of Maryland, a subordinate camp of the State Camp of Maryland, Patriotic Order Sons of America."

Leave was granted to the Allegany county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to provide for a new reservoir for the town of Frostburg, Allegany county, and to authorize the Mayor and Councilmen of said town to issue bonds to pay the costs thereof."

Leave was granted to the Committee on Roads and Highways to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to provide for construction of model or experimental work in each county in the State, and to make an appropriation therefor."
