House bill entitled "An Act to refund to Enoch B. Abell, Clerk to the Circuit Court for St. Mary's county, \$23.75 erroneously paid into the State treasury."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Comptroller of Baltimore city, and the Comptroller of the State, respectively, to refund to August C. Schmidt money erroneously paid into the treasuries, respectively, of said State and municipalities for licenses,
