REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

Mr. Staley, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 9 A, of chapter 381, of the Acts of Assembly, passed January session 1888, entitled 'An Act to amend the charter of the Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington county.'"

Which was read a second time.

The Speaker, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with proposed amendment,

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize the qualified voters of Pocomoke city, Worcester county, to decide by ballot whether or not coupon bonds not exceeding the amount of \$8,000, shall be issued by said city for the purpose of providing a proper electric light^a plant for said city."
